It seems hard to believe that we are already into the summer term and now looking forward to an improvement in the weather so we can make full use of our wonderful outdoor facilities. During this term, the children will be working on the related themes of Animals, New Life and Growth. As part of this work, the children will have the opportunity to observe “Painted Lady Caterpillars” from Insectlore, so the children can watch them grow and develop into butterflies over several weeks and learn about the life-cycle of the butterfly.

The Play House

This week the children have had the opportunity to work with “The Play House” Theatre Company on their new production “**Climb Aboard**” which is a participatory theatre-in-education programme, for Nursery aged children from **Language Alive!** The children have the opportunity to work collaboratively with one another and the artists in a multi-sensory environment. The £900.00 cost of this event will be met entirely from the school budget.

Animal Man - Tuesday 16th June - Stefan will be bringing in a variety of animals, such as snakes, creepy-crawlies and, hopefully, a beautiful owl. The £250 cost of this event will be met entirely from school fund.

Induction Days - Please note that school will be closed on **Wednesday 24th June and Wednesday 1st July** as these are our Induction Days - this is for parents with children starting nursery in September. This is “move-up” day for Birmingham Local Authority Primary Schools and many of you will be visiting your new schools on the same day.

Hatton Adventure World - Family Trip – Tuesday 7th July – This will be a great family day out. Letters have been sent out earlier this week with all relevant details and a booking form.

“Crackers the Clown” –Wednesday 8th July

As a special treat, “Crackers the Clown” has been booked to entertain the children with a comedy show. The £130.00 cost of this event will be met entirely from school funds.

Afternoon children 2.30 pm


Teddy Bears Picnic and Party - Wednesday 15th July
